Graduated Tokyo University, Dept. of Economics. Entered Nippon Gakki Co., Ltd. (now Yamaha) in 1953. Appointed director of Yamaha Motor Co. in 1968, in charge of executive affairs, then, in 1980, became executive vice president of Nippon Gakki Co. Appointed president and C.E.O. of Yamaha Motor Co. in 1983. Sixty-four years old.

Seisuke Ueshima

Graduated Keio University, Dept. of Economics, 1958, and entered Nippon Gakki Co., Ltd. (now Yamaha). Appointed director of Yamaha Motor Co. in 1971, became managing director of Nippon Gakki in 1981, appointed executive vice president in 1983. Appointed president on February 19, 1992. Fifty-seven years old.

Teruo Hiyoshi

Graduated Tokyo Institute of Technology. Entered Nippon Gakki Co., Ltd. in 1959. Appointed head of Electronic Instruments Production Division in 1980, then appointed director in 1982. Became managing director in 1987, serving concurrently as head of Electronic Musical Instruments Division since 1988. Fifty-nine years old.
