Dear Dr. Chowning,

Since 1988, for the first time, I plan to visit the States again in next month and if you are available, I would like to have time with you.

I will be with a professor at Hyogo Education University whose name is Hiroshi Suzuki and who initiated "Synthesizer Orchestra" in a school in Japan, wrote the book for DX and is writing a series of article for Japanese Music Trade about DTM (Desk Top Music).

The objective of our trip is to study and up-date the present situation of technology and application in North America in relation to "Electronic Music and Instruments". Our aim is to find and get any hints for promotion of "Electronic Music and Instruments" for future.

Our itinerary includes visit to ICMC in Montreal, visit to several universities and colleges in East Coast and Midwest and then come over to California.

We will arrive at Montreal on October 17th and stay at DELTA Montreal 18th and 19th, leaving for New York on Sunday 20th. If you are there, we may be able to have time then.

In San Francisco area, we have time between afternoon of the following Sunday 27th to morning of 29th before moving to Los Angeles.

If you are available, we can have dinner meeting either on 27th or 28th, or breakfast or lunch meeting either 28th or 29th, though we may need to move to LA in the morning of 29th. Of course, morning or afternoon of 28th is okay with us, though we plan to visit Cary Leuenburg store and our YST San Jose office this day.
