267	Lab Studio	With computer terminal. Specially suited for listening and demonstrations because of relative quiet, size, and high ceiling. Four channel sound system.

179	Record. Studio	With computer terminal. The quietest space in the building having concrete floor and some wall treatment. Used for direct digital recording for both compositional and research purposes.
