Dear Les,

I want to confirm in writing my understanding that when A. I. vacates its space at the D. C. Power Building, that space will be left essentially empty. That is, all furniture and equipment of use to you will be moved to Jacks, all items of any salvage value will be sold through Investment Recovery (or reused by other University programs*if Sydney so determines), and all remaining junk will be hailed to the dump. I am particularly concerned about your storage areas on the Lower Level. You are the only ones who can make a determination about ultimate disposition of the items there and I see it as your responsibility to do so and to clear the space out.
