- 1. You will be contacted one of these days (must be before June 27) by Japan Air Line office in Paris to obtain your Air-Ticket (round trip: Paris-Tokyo-Paris). I have reserved your seat in the flight of JAL 440 departing Paris July 15 (Sunday) at 14:00.
- 2. I reserved your hotel in Hamamatsu at SAGANO Hotel, the same Japanese style hotel that you stayed at, in 1977.
- 3. On your arrival at Tokyo (NARITA Airport), you will be welcomed by myself. This time the true Yohei Nagai will be there.
- 4. The followings are rough items to be done in Hamamatsu during your stay:

- (4-3) If you could agree, NGK staffs would be happy to listen to your lecture of some 90 minutes on FM sound synthesis, general digital sound synthesizing technique, your suggestions to future electronic musical instruments and your opinion or prediction to future total music world. (tape, slide, and overhead-projector available)
- 5. For those items I count six or seven working days including some interruption of negotiation time together with MMr. Reimers and Hudnall, who are coming to Hamamatsu on July 18 and 19. Therefore you will be able to leave Hamamatsu on around July 24 or 25 or 26th.
