Possible Private Funding

Rockefeller Foundation - On Oct. 28, 1979, a letter was sent to Howard Klein, Director for Arts regarding possible support for CCRMA. Although support in 1980 was denied, Klein suggested the possibility of support in 1981. I met with Klein in N.Y. on March 20, 1980 at which time Klein showed a real interest in supporting CCRMA and proposed the following schedule; he will visit CCRMA in June, together we plan a proposal which will be completed by February 1, 1981, the proposal will be submitted to the board of directors on April 1, 1981 for approval. Klein felt it premature to consider level of funding; however, in view of his grants to UCSD for similar projects, it seems that a request for no less than \$200,000 would be appropriate.

W. Alton Jones Foundation - a letter was sent on January 3, 1980 and a meeting was arranged with Mr. Espanole, vice president of the foundation. He had no file and asked to keep my copy of the original letter to the foundation. He said that funding for CCRMA would be considered at the June meeting. No optimism here.

Exxon - I talked with Elissa Szymanki, Advisor, Cultural and Communications Programs, Public Affairs Department. Her advice was to ask Pierre Boulez to write to Stephen Stamas, Vice president for Public Affairs, requesting a meeting with the three of us at a time when Boulez is in N.Y., or otherwise a meeting of Stamas and Chowning with Boulez's blessing. I will try and work this out with Boulez.

Fromm Music Foundation - P. Boulez introduced me to Paul Fromm in N.Y. several years ago. In response to a phone conversation and a following letter, he will discuss the possibility of awarding a "token grant" to CCRMA at the director's meeting in May.

Mrs. Doreen Townsend - On March 28 Mrs. Townsend visited CCRMA. She met many of the students and staff and she was both delightful and delighted with what she heard and saw. I am trying, now, to arrange to see her and ask once more for her support.
